Winter Meeting Rule Determinations

Q1. Should we add an extra SIM day during the regular season?

A. We will SIM and extra day during the Regular Season (Tuesday) [Yes 12, No 0]

Q2. Should we turn on BABIP in S+?

A. BABIP is now turned on in S+ [Yes 12, No 0]

Q3. Should we change the Age for the Rule 5 Draft?

A. The current Rule 5 status stays; no one under the age of 22 can be drafted [Not exceeded 60%]

Q4. Should we add a Winter Develop League?

A. We're adding a Winter Development League in the Fall of 1949 [Yes 8, Ask next year 5, - 62%]

Q5. Should AAA winning franchise get a \$100k bonus?

A. NO AAA winning Club will receive no bonus [Yes 5, No 7, - 57%]

Q6. Change Draft Pick Trading from one season forward to two seasons?

A. No change stays at one season forward [not enough total votes 9]

Q7. *Incorporate the DH starting in 1950 season?*

A. Staying with No DH [Yes 5, No 8, 62%]

Q8. 1000k seat expansion based upon GM export rate of 85% for season in S+ Export Tracker? NOTE: This will be from the start of off-season 1949 to start of off-season 1950.

A. Will be added to the 1950 season [Yes 9, No 1, 90%]

Q9. Expansion by 8 teams for the 1951 season?

A. We will expand based upon discussion in #rule_discussions [1950 0, 1951 13, 1952 0, 100%]
